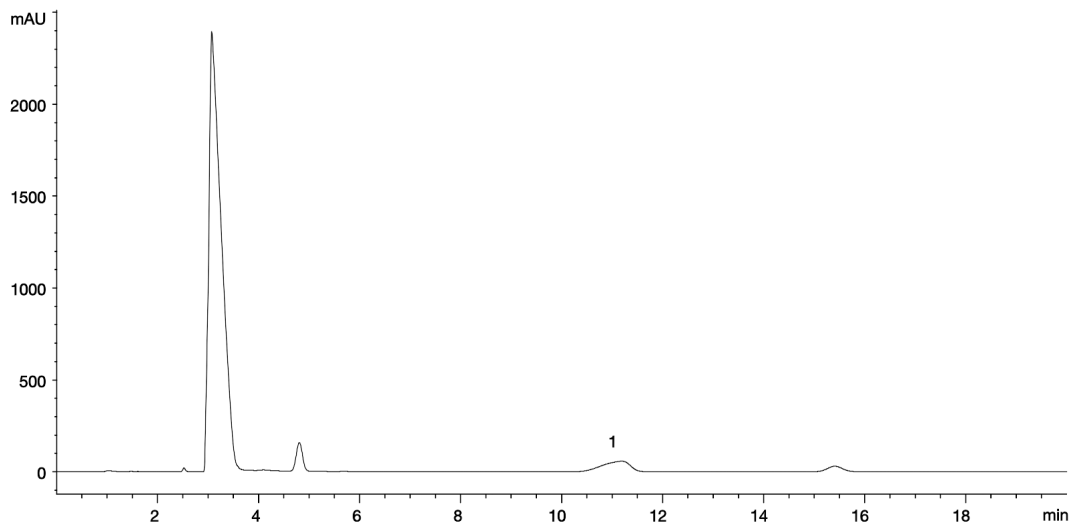
Detection: LC/UV (DAD, PDA) @ 220.000000000 nm (nanometers) (ambient)

Analyst Note: Hydrocortisone cream dissolve 1g of Hydrocortisone cream in 10mL ethyl acetate (n=6)

2. Dilute 2mL of ethyl acetate-cream sample with 8mL methanol:water (1:1)
3. Load 400µL methanol:water (1:1) cream sample
4. Push sample through filter vial
5. Analyze final eluate via HPLC-UV
